School Requisites, Swimming, Book Rental. See details overleaf.

In the past there had been a practice of collecting money throughout the school year for various bits and pieces as the need arose. We have decided to keep the cost of the one-off payment at €20 per child to cover the cost of art & craft materials, photocopying, standardised tests, your child's homework journal, pupils personal accident insurance and postage of school reports etc. for the year. When giving this to your child please put it in an envelope (notes or cheques) with your child's name on it and €20 for "**School Requisites**" on the front please.

We are including the cost of swimming for the coming year on the book list. 1<sup>st</sup> Class will go swimming for 10 sessions at a cost of €7 per session. The total cost of €70 can be paid weekly or preferably as a one-off payment. If you prefer to pay weekly, we collect for two weeks (€14) at the beginning and this must be paid before the first session. Please note that the cost of the swimming has been calculated using the number of children in the class and therefore the cost will be €70 even if your child misses sessions. Again, when giving this to your child please put it in an envelope (notes or cheques) with your child's name on it and amount being paid for "**Swimming**" on the front please.

**N.B. Please do not combine money for brothers or sisters in one envelope. If at all possible please pay for each child separately to that child's teacher.** This is much more convenient for the school. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.

Indoor shoes are needed from 1<sup>st</sup> Class onwards (we strongly advise a canvas shoe with a rubber sole or plimsoll).

**Please ensure that your child's name is on all possessions to ensure prompt return of lost property, particularly pencils and colouring pencils as they are frequently lost.**
